### **The School**

Our Lady of Walsingham Academy, founded in 2021, is an independent day school providing a Catholic and classical liberal arts education to boys and girls in grades 9-12.

### **The Mission**

Our aim is to form liberally educated Catholic ladies and gentlemen. We focus on the classics of Western thought and the interrelationships of timeless ideas. The best education appreciates truth, beauty, and goodness, and helps students grow in the cardinal virtues of prudence, temperance, fortitude, and justice. Such emphasis produces articulate, clear-thinking, well-rounded, and joyful young people prepared to reflect Christ in the modern world.

### **Curriculum:**

The headmaster leads the faculty expert in their respective fields, all of whom take an oath of fidelity to the Magisterium, the official teaching authority of the Catholic Church. OLWA's course of studies is based on the classical understanding of the liberal arts: the trivium of grammar, rhetoric, and logic, which are the arts dealing with language and the mind, and the quadrivium of arithmetic, geometry, music, and astronomy which are the arts concerning discrete and continuous quantity. We believe that every student deserves a one-on-one encounter with the greatest works of Western Civilization. Students read and discuss original texts, the Great Books of the Western world. From the study of the Bible and Euclid's Elements of Geometry to the Federalist Papers, OLWA students are immersed in the perennial ideas at the very core of Western Civilization and will, as Newton says, see further because "they stand on the shoulders of giants."

### **Fine Arts**

Every student is a member of the schola which performs serious polyphonic works. Students also perform a Greek Tragedy or Shakespearean Comedy every year. Visual arts and art history figure prominently in the curriculum, and many students also enjoy ballroom dance and folk dance instruction.

### **Spiritual Formation:**

Every school day begins with Mass. The Sacrament of Reconciliation is offered frequently. Prayer opens and closes every class. The schola learns Mass in the extraordinary and ordinary forms, and students participate in an occasional Eucharistic Procession.

### **Admission:**

Admission to Our Lady of Walsingham Academy is based on school records, personal interviews, teacher recommendations, and standardized testing. By design, enrollment hovers around 50 students, 10 to 20 per class. The tuition for 2026-2027 is \$8,400.
